LEADD is a cooperative effort by Emmaus Homes and St. Charles Community College's Continuing Education Department to offer non-credit adult continuing education opportunities for persons with developmental disabilities, ages 16 and older. Sessions are designed to teach independent living skills and provide life-enhancing experiences in a community educational and social environment.

The curriculum aims to promote growth opportunities and challenge the abilities of individuals who desire to live and work as independently as possible.

## OUR MISSION

LEADD promotes community membership, academic growth, independence and personal enrichment through continuing education classes that support the needs of persons with developmental disabilities and enhances opportunities for individuals to achieve positive outcomes in an educational environment.

## CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

All students who attend 4 out of 5 **LEADD** classes will receive a certificate of completion, which is awarded at the graduation ceremony on the last day of classes.
